## **CIRCULAR**

14th November, 2021

- 1. NCCOEEE National chapter met virtually on 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2011 to discuss and decide forthcoming plan of activities related to the Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021 and further steps being adopted by the Government of India as well some state Governments. Shri R K Tripathy presided over the meeting. Brief points have already been intimated through WhatsApp communication. Following decisions arrived through discussion are appended below.
- 2. Anti-Power Sector Privatisation / Anti-Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021 Day will be observed on 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, i.e. on the First Day of Winter session of the Parliament. All state chapters will organise demonstration at state capitals with mobilisation of electricity employees and engineers from selective area to hand over Memorandum of NCCOEEE addressed to the Prime Minister to the Governor with prior Appointment. Otherwise, will be sent par e-mail after the demonstration. Similar demonstration will be organised at District Headquarters and Power Plants. Draft memorandum will be sent from NCCOEEE National Chapter covering the manipulated power crisis on the plea of Coal shortage, sky level price hike for energy exchange, while independent power producers reduced their generation and further weakening of Distribution sector by transferring 33 KV network to Transmission sector besides Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021
- 3. NCCOEEE National Chapter will physically meet at Delhi on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2021. All NCCOEEE constituents will ensure availability of their fore front leadership at Delhi between 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> December next to organise collective approach from NCCOEEE to the MPs and political parties opposing Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021 to intensify the struggle in and outside the Parliament against this Anti-people draconian Bill, while Government goes ahead with the legislation process.
- 4. NCCOEEE took note of the Declaration of National Convention of Workers held on 11<sup>th</sup> November at Delhi. The Convention decided to organise countrywide massive demonstration on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 on the completion of one year of historic unified struggle of Workers and Peasants from 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2020. NCCOEEE constituents are requested to join this demonstration, wherever possible.
