CIRCULAR

21st November, 2021

- 1. NCCOEEE National chapter convey warm greetings to Samyukta Kisan Morcha (SKM) and members of all its 500 constituents for their one year long historic struggle to repeal three Farm Acts and withdrawal of Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021. NCCOEEE also pay respectful homage to 700 martyrs in this struggle. First phase of the struggle became victorious through declaration of the Prime Minister towards repealing the Acts with apology to countrymen. NCCOEEE also greets members of all its constituents, who took part in various forms of solidarity struggle in support of the farmers.
- 2. Out of all the demands of SKM, Prime Minister kept silence on the Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021. Hence, NCCOEEE is to carry forward its struggle against this draconian Bill. Winter session of the Parliament will commence from 29th November but the Agenda is yet to be notified. In this circumstances, Nation wide Protest demonstration of NCCOEEE on 29th November as decided on 11th November and notified on 14th November is postponed for the time being.
- 3. Physical meeting of NCCOEEE National Chapter at Delhi fixed on 30th November, 2021 is deferred to 3rd December at 12-30 PM. Effort to organise collective approach from NCCOEEE to the MPs and political parties opposing Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021 to intensify the struggle in and outside the Parliament against this Anti-people Bill, if Government goes ahead with the legislation process will be continued. NCCOEEE State Chapters may also contact the Members of Parliaments of the political parties opposing the Bill in the respective states.
- 4. NCCOEEE noted that SKM has decided to carry forward their struggle for the remaining demands including withdrawal of Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2021. Massive demonstration will take place at Delhi and state Capitals on 26th November, 2021 on the anniversary of the commencement day of historic unified struggle of Workers and Peasants from 26th November, 2020 . NCCOEEE constituents are requested to join this demonstration, wherever possible.
