**24<sup>th</sup> March, 2022**



As decided, and invited all sections of people and organisations opposing Power Privatisation in Chandigarh took part in the convention. Leaders of Peasants, workers, Youth and Women Movement, Corporation Councillors addressed the full house convention. NCCOEEE constituents and leaders from Northern Region and National leaders of NCCOEEE took part and addressed the Convention. Besides National leaders of NCCOEEE, Participants were mainly from UP, Haryana, Delhi, Punjab, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir besides Chandigarh.

Shri Shailendra Dubey chaired the Convention. Adopted Resolution of the Convention is being circulated with this circular. Com Subhas Lamba moved the draft Resolution and Prasanta N. Chowdhury narrated plan of action and follow up therefrom after 28-29 March Nationwide Strike, at the event of Chandigarh administration's failure to redress the grievances focused through resolution of the Convention.
