All of us are aware that half a million Coal workers of our country has resorted to path of strike action against dubious proposition of Government of India towards curtailment of social security benefit of the workers and employees of Coal industry of India to the tune of 1/3 of existing. They intend to merge Coal Mines Provident Fund (CMPF) with Employees Provident Fund (EPF). Other demands of United Forum of Coal Workers' Organisations are abolition of contract system in perennial nature of jobs and Equal Wage for Equal Work for the contract workers, full implementation of 9th wage agreement for Coal workers as well 10th settlement by the earliest. Coal workers also oppose withdrawal of decision on closure of Coal Mines. The three days strike between 19th & 21st June will put a thrust upon Narendra Modi-Piyush Goyal Government.

EEFI with all its constituents is also on the path of struggle for protecting the public sector Electricity Industry including compliance of Apex Court Order to Stop Contractorisation of work of permanent/perennial nature, Ensuring payment of Equal wages and benefits to the contract workers at the same rate as available to the regular workers till regularization of all the contract workers. Stop FDI in Railways, Insurance and Defense and disinvestment of PSUs, hold upon Transfer of National Assets and Resources to Private Hands, hold upon Anti-Labour Labour Laws Amendment and to Ensure Electricity for all at affordable cost.

EEFI notes with grave concern that Government of India, started siphoning accumulated Provident Fund of workers to risk prone stock market. Further step taken was unbundling of Social Security Organisations in the name of Social Security Code. Stop FDI in Railways, Insurance and Defense and disinvestment of PSUs, hold upon Transfer of National Assets and Resources to Private Hands, hold upon Anti-Worker Labour Laws Amendment and to Ensure Electricity for all at affordable cost. Electricity (Amendment), Bill, 2014 has been designed to curb the rights to electrical energy of people of India to extend profit of private profit monger in the power sector through splitting carriage and content.
