2. 3rd World Congress of TUI (Energy)

A) Reception Committee for hosting 3rd World Congress of TUI (Energy) in India has been constituted at Thiruvananthapuram on 27th June, 2018 in presence of members of mass organisations of Kerala, Electricity employees, Coal, Petroleum & Gas workers with their leadership. Reception Committee is headed by E. Karim, MP. Other main constituents are K O Habeeb, Chief Patron with Patrons Swadesh Devroye, Prasanta Nandi Chowdhury, Nogen Chutia (Petroleum & Gas Workers Federation) D.D. Ramanandan (Coal Workers Federation), Viswanathan (FMRI), K Jaypakash, General Conveners, with assignments of responsibilities among all EEFI Office Bearers of Kerala. Com. Pinnari Vijayan, Chief Minister of Kerala will inaugurate the congress at Trivandrum on 11th September.

Massive campaign will be organized throughout the state of Kerala. EEFI constituents in different parts of India will also carry forward the message of this important global congress

among the Electricity Workers & people all over the country when global capitalist-imperialist nexus is hatching the game plan of curbing right to Energy of poor people of all countries including India.

- B) All Office Bearers of EEFI will take part as delegate of this 3rd World Congress of TUI (Energy) on 11-12 September, 2018. In addition to Office Bearers, one each from following states /organisations will be elected as delegate. In Case, any EEFI office bearer is not in a position to attend, any office bearer of the concerned organisation may be nominated as delegate with prior intimation to EEFI centre.

- C) Estimated cost for hosting the congress will be Rs.35 lakhs. Major expenses for the congress will be borne by KSEBWA & KSEBOA. Other EEFI constituents are requested to collect @ Rs 10 per member towards the expenses of the congress and remit to EEFI centre in 2 instalments by the end of July & August.
- D) Soft copies of display campaign material is attached to this circular for circulation in Print and social media campaign and web sites of our organisations. Printed copies of large dimension poster was issued to the participants of reception committee formation meeting. Some will be distributed through the participants of TU school in Pandichery and Faridabad.

3. Preparation for wider struggle


- A. It is expected that since discussion and decisions in last Working Committee Meeting, all our constituents are making preparation for successful participation in nationwide movement of working class in state based rally on 15 points demands.
- B. All constituents are requested to keep EEFI centre updated with the following information. To what extent preparation of taking part in Mazdoor Kisan Sangharsh Rally to Parliament on 5th September is in progress, we need to have interim review.
- (1) Nos. of Participants (2) Mode of journey to and from Delhi (3) Accommodation arrangement at Delhi, (4) Decoration material with banner, placards & other form of display, (5) EEFI Identification.
- C. Awareness campaign on Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2014 through handbill, pamphlets & public contacts.
- D. EEFI responsibility lies to lead and organize public awareness campaign, rally and State level NCCOEEE convention along with preparatory activities for All India Strike in the following states:
- (1) Kerala, (2) Tamil Nadu, (3) Odisha, (4) West Bengal, (5) Himachal Pradesh, (6) Haryana, (7) Punjab, (8) Jammu & Kashmir, (9) Tripura.

Besides above states all EEFI organisations are to track with the responsible organisations for holding the activities like public awareness campaign, rally and State level NCCOEEE convention along with preparatory activities for All India Strike. - E. As per available information, Government of India may try to pass the Electricity (Amendment) Bill, 2014 in Parliament either in this monsoon / winter session. We are to be prepared for a Flash strike, which will not be possible, if we are not in constant touch simultaneously with our rank and file & NCCOEEE state & national constituents.
- F. EEFI Office.
